





Preset 4 – YOUR own preset



O1 Configure your settings in the SPEAKER window and, if necessary, in the DSP OUT window.



Now you can select your saved settings directly on the loudspeaker by selecting Preset 4, even without a network connection to the computer.



O2 Select preset 4 in the main window.



O3
Click on 'Store' and confirm by clicking on 'OK'.
Preset 4 will now be saved in the speaker box with your new settings.

You can save your settings for the SPEAKER and DSP OUT as Preset 4 in your HK Audio speaker cabinet. This allows you to switch between the three presets we have created and your own preset at any time, even without a computer, simply by using the controls on the rear of the cabinet.




Groups

A subgroup can be used to change the level of multiple signals. In addition, this group can be processed with a 5-band EQ, delay and limiter.



O1 Click on 'Tools', click on 'New Group'.



O2 Enter a group name.







Click on the green arrow to change the group settings.




Delay




Click on the speaker you want to edit.



O2 Click on 'SPEAKER' or 'DSP OUT'.



O3 Click on the desired unit.




O4 Enter the delay value using the fader or by double-clicking.

The parameters for the 'SPEAKER' and the 'DSP OUT' are identical. You can delay the signal at the DSP OUT output, for example. This makes it very easy to create a delay line.




Equalizer



Click on the speaker you want to edit.




O2 Click on 'SPEAKER' or 'DSP OUT'.



O3 Select a filter type in one of the ten bands.



Enter the value for the frequency (Freq), the quality factor (Q) and the gain/attenuation in dB (Gain).



Alternatively, you can use the mouse to change the values in the graph.

The parameters for the 'SPEAKER' and the 'DSP-OUT' are identical.




Update




O1 Click on 'Tools', click on 'Enable Update'.




02 Enter the password: HK_adm.






O4 Confirm the information by clicking on 'OK'.





Once the update is complete, click on 'Tools', 'Disable Update'.




O Enter a user password of your choice.

Download the newer version and install it to use new features.


The firmware files for the speakers do not need to be downloaded separately, as they are part of the DSP Control software.




Change background image

O2 Select a background image.




To delete the image, click on 'Remove Background Image'.

Press and hold the preset button for ten seconds (the four LEDs will flash twice in succession. Release the preset button after all four LEDs have flashed twice).
